# Annual Meeting

The 47th Annual Meeting of the Services Center Federal Credit Union will be held on Saturday, June 20, 2009. The election process will once again be conducted by ballot box. Eligible Credit Union members will be able to vote during regular business hours on June 17, 18, and 19th at any of our three Credit Union locations. All elections will be determined by plurality vote.

The Services Center Federal Credit Union Nominating Committee submits the following candidates for three 3-year terms for the 2009 Board of Directors election. Here are the candidates:

**Eugene Bormann**: graduated from Yankton College in 1963 with a degree in biology, physical education and secondary education and obtained his masters degree in science education from Michigan State University. Gene taught/coached in Lennox High School, Lennox SD, Yankton High School and in the Newcastle School District in Newcastle NE. Gene retired from teaching at the end of the 2006-2007 school year and now works in the Endangered Species Section of the US Army Corps of Engineers. He serves on several boards and committees including the council of his church, the Environment Education Connections of South Dakota, and of course the Services Center FCU. Gene has served on the Board of Directors for 6 years and has served as 1st Vice-Chairman and Secretary.

**Mary Malchow**: graduated from USD with a BS and MA degree in Communication Disorders. She has been employed with the Yankton School District for 31 years as a Speech/Language Pathologist. Mary has served on the Services Center FCU Supervisory Committee for 5 years before joining the Services Center FCU Board of Directors in 2003. As a member of the Board of Directors, Mary has held the position of Secretary, 1st Vice-Chair, Vice-Chair and two terms as Chairman of the Board.

**Alice Petrik**: retired in March 2005 from the State of South Dakota after 26 years of service. The last 16 years included working at the Mike Durfee State Prison in Springfield, SD as a Library Clerk and Microfilm Supervisor. Alice graduated with a 2 year degree in teaching and an associate degree in Library Science from USD/Springfield. Alice serves on the Tyndall Good Samaritan Nursing Home Board, Tabor Czech Heritage Board, Springfield Historical Society Museum Board, The Springfield College Archives/Museum Board and president of the Dwight Wood Legion Auxiliary where she was selected as 2009 Legionette of the Year. Alice is an active member of the St. Vincent's Catholic Church, where she is co-chairman of the Altar Society and serves as a Eucharistic Minister, lector and money counter. She is also a volunteer driver for Bon Homme County taking the elderly to doctors appointments and volunteers at the Nutrition Center helping the elderly with mail, grocery shopping and cleaning. Alice has served on the Services Center FCU Board of Directors since 2006 and has held the position of Secretary.

The Credit Union will also accept nominations by petition from the members. Each petition must include the qualifications of the nominee and be signed by at least 64 members of the Credit Union. Each petition must also include biographical data on the nominee. Each nominee must sign a statement indicating that they are agreeable to such nomination and will serve if elected to office.
