**Changes to the Minimum Balance Requirements
On Savings Accounts**

With the effective date of May 1st, for dividends paid to your savings account on May 31st, you must maintain a daily balance of at least \$100.00 in your savings account each day to obtain the disclosed annual percentage yield. Once an account balance exceeds the required minimum balance, dividends will be paid on the entire amount in the account for that day.

Annual Meeting

The 48th Annual Meeting of the Services Center Federal Credit Union will be held on Saturday, June 26, 2010. The election process will once again be conducted by ballot box. Eligible Credit Union members will be able to vote during regular business hours on June 23, 24, and 25th at any of our three Credit Union locations. All elections will be determined by plurality vote.

The Services Center Federal Credit Union Nominating Committee submits the following candidates for two 3-year terms for the 2010 Board of Directors election. Here are the candidates:

Michelle Schulte: has been a self-employed day care provider for the past 22 years. Michelle grew up by Fordyce, NE and went to school in Hartington, NE. She served on the YHS Band Boosters for 8 years as the Chairman of Fundraisers and also served as Chairman of Fundraisers for Boy Scouts.

The Credit Union will also accept nominations by petition from the members. Each petition must include the qualifications of the nominee and be signed by at least 64 members of the Credit Union. Each petition must also include biographical data on the nominee. Each nominee must sign a statement indicating that they are agreeable to such nomination and will serve if elected to office.
