# Annual Meeting

The 49th Annual Meeting of the Services Center Federal Credit Union will be held on Saturday, June 25, 2011. The election process will once again be conducted by ballot box. Eligible Credit Union members will be able to vote during regular business hours on June 22, 23, and 24th at any of our three Credit Union locations. All elections will be determined by plurality vote.

The Services Center Federal Credit Union Nominating Committee submits the following candidates for two 3-year terms for the 2011 Board of Directors election. Here are the candidates:

**Donald Fiedler**: has been employed as a Postal Clerk with the US Post Office since 1990. Don graduated from Yankton High School in 1972 and Yankton College in 1980 with a Bachelors Degree in Business Administration. Don has been a SCFCU Board of Director since 2008.

## TIPS TO KEEP YOUR VISA DEBIT CARD SECURE AND ACTIVE:

1. Once you receive your VISA Debit Card in the mail, activate, sign the back of your card right away and store the PIN number in a safe place. For your protection, all debit cards not activated within 90 days may be subject to removal from the system and become non-operational.
2. All debit cards that have no transaction history for 180 days may be subject to removal from the system and become non-operational.
3. Test your card at any merchant and/or ATM prior to any planned vacations or travels.
4. If you misplace your debit card you can call VISA's 24-hour 800-543-5073 to have VISA immediately prevent your card from further use.
